

**DISSOLUTION PLAN
THE SWEDEN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

The Town Board of the Town of Sweden proposes to dissolve the Sweden Fire Protection District, contingent upon the establishment of the Brockport Fire District.

- (a) The type of entity to be dissolved is a fire protection district. The name of the local government entity to be dissolved is the Sweden Fire Protection District.
- (b) The territorial boundaries of the Sweden Fire Protection District encompass the entire geographic area of the Town of Sweden, outside the boundaries of the incorporated Village of Brockport.
- (c) The fiscal estimate of the cost of dissolution of the Sweden Fire District is approximately \$25,000 for professional fees, publication fees and disbursements. The Town of Sweden currently pays \$321,022.73 to the Village of Brockport for fire protection. That item will be eliminated from Sweden's Town budget as a result of dissolution.
- (d) The Sweden Fire Protection District currently does not employ any individuals. Accordingly, there is no plan for the transfer or elimination of public employees because of the dissolution.
- (e) The Sweden Fire Protection District currently possesses no assets. The Town Board of the Town of Sweden will authorize the transfer of Town owned land to the Brockport Fire District, upon which the Town of Sweden, at its sole expense, will construct a building for use by the Brockport Fire District. The cost of construction of this building shall be no less than \$125,000.00. This land and building transfer will be without consideration.
- (f) The Sweden Fire Protection District has no liabilities and indebtedness, bonded and otherwise.
- (g) The Sweden Fire Protection District is situated in the Town of Sweden. Currently, the Town of Sweden has a fire protection agreement with the Village of Brockport which ends on December 31, 2012, which could be terminated earlier according to a Memorandum of Understanding as well as a Modification and Extension Agreement executed by the Village of Brockport, Town of Clarkson and the Town of Sweden.
- (h) The residents of the Sweden Fire Protection District will be furnished fire protection services by the newly established Brockport Fire District, following the dissolution of the Sweden Fire Protection District. The level of fire protection services will remain the same as is currently provided within the Sweden Fire Protection District by the agreement with the Village of Brockport.

- (i) The Sweden Fire Protection District owns no assets and liabilities and indebtedness. Any taxes levied, collected and allocated to the Sweden Fire Protection District will be expended by the effective date of dissolution, pursuant to the terms of the fire protection agreement with the Village, which expires December 31, 2012. There will be no unexpended taxes for the fire protection district as of December 31, 2012. Should there be any unexpended monies in the Sweden Fire Protection District budget, such monies will be paid to the newly formed Brockport Fire District, which will be used for fire protection until the Brockport Fire District can levy its own taxes commencing January 2013.
- (j) The Sweden Fire Protection District did not adopt, nor make, any rules or regulations for the Sweden Fire Protection District. Accordingly, there will not be any rules or regulations remaining after the effective date of dissolution.
- (k) The effective date of the proposed dissolution is June 30, 2012 at 11:59 p.m., contingent upon the successful establishment of the Brockport Fire District.
- (l) The public hearing on the proposed dissolution plan will be held at the Sweden Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on September 20, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.
- (m) In order to carry out this dissolution, the Brockport Fire District must be established so that there is uninterrupted fire protection for those residents of the Town of Sweden currently provided fire protection by the Sweden Fire Protection District.
