

At 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Milner called to order a public hearing located at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York on Tuesday, October 27, 2009. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear all persons interested in the budget, in favor of or against the Preliminary Budget for 2010, or any item therein to include the compensation to be paid to all elected Town Officials, pursuant to the requirements of Section 108 of the Town Law.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor John Milner, Councilperson Rob Carges, Councilperson Patricia Connors, Councilperson Michael Myers, and Councilperson Danielle Windus-Cook. Also present were Finance Director Leisa Strabel, Highway Superintendent Fred Perrine, and Town Clerk Karen Sweeting.

Visitors present were Dave Weever and residents Jim Hamlin and Rick Popen.

Supervisor Milner asked Town Clerk Karen Sweeting to read the legal notice published in the Town newspapers. Notice was read.

Councilperson Carges presented the 2010 Preliminary Budget and opened the floor for comments. Discussion of exempt properties – 49% in the Town of Sweden being one of the highest in Monroe County due to the college, churches, school district, etc.

Supervisor Milner asked if anyone had any further comments or questions. No other comments or questions were made.

The public hearing remained open until 7:18 p.m. No additional visitors attended.
