A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Sweden was held at the Town Hall, 18 State Street, Brockport, New York, on Tuesday, October 8, 2024.

Town Board Members present were Supervisor Patricia Hayles, Councilperson Scott Maar, Councilperson Tyler Sharpe, Councilperson Adam Staskiewicz, and Councilperson Gary Sullivan. Also present were Finance Director Hiedi Librock, Town Attorney Jim Bell, Superintendent of Highways Brian Ingraham, and Town Clerk Karen Sweeting.

Visitors present were Pat Cliff, Karen LoBracco, Don Pophal, and John Seymour.

Supervisor Hayles called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked everyone present to say the Pledge to the Flag and remain standing for a moment of silence in memoriam of Tod Brudz (Phyllis Brudz's husband), all those in harm's way due to the severe weather, for our first responders, and those in the armed services.

PUBLIC HEARING:

At 6:02 p.m. Supervisor Hayles called to order four (4) public hearings. The purpose of the public hearings was to hear all persons for or against the adoption of Local Laws imposing six (6) month moratoriums on Chapter 55 Assemblies, Public applications, Chapter 172 Abandonment and Decommissioning Plans, Chapter 174 Solar Farms/Commercial Solar Power Projects, and Chapter 176 Battery Energy Storage Systems in the Town of Sweden.

Supervisor Hayles explained the moratoriums are necessary to give the board time to consider updates and changes to the Sweden Town Code. The board feels there are sections of the current code that are conflicting and burdensome and want to improve those sections. Mrs. Hayles will form a committee to review the code and present recommendations.

Supervisor Hayles waived the reading of the legal notices.

Resident Karen LoBracco addressed the board focusing on Chapter 55 Assemblies. Ms. LoBracco asked that the board consider changes in language around gender and consider accessibility in the requirements for an assembly.

Resident John Seymour addressed the board explaining that he is surrounded by fields that he has heard may become a solar farm. Supervisor Hayles said the Town has three current solar farms in the Town and, at this time, there are no applications in front of the Planning Board for consideration.

Town Attorney Jim Bell explained some of the concerns with Chapters 172 and 174. The committee will go over the entire code and make recommendations, if any, to the board for consideration. The local law on the agenda tonight for consideration addresses the moratorium for six months, no applications can be filed for consideration during that period of time. Supervisor Hayles added that a public hearing would be held before any changes to the code were approved.

Resident Pat Cliff is also concerned about additional solar farm projects.
