REPORTS OF DEPARTMENTS AND BOARD MEMBERS:

Recreation Director Jill Wisnowski wanted to recognize Amanda Kinney, Caitlin Curley, and Megan Lester for going above and beyond this past year. Goals for 2025:

- ➤ Playground funded by Monroe County ARPA funds
- > Skateboard instructor teaching on flat surface for now, but will be utilizing skate park at some point
- Fishing Deck utilize instructor for fishing lessons for a few different age groups

- Fitness Center rearranging and replacing/upgrading equipment in process through 2025.
- ➤ Brockport Schools have gone to digital printing which will increase our cost to print brochures. We will no longer be able to utilize Publisher in 2026 to create the brochure and the Suburban News is no longer delivering to homes. This will cause some changes to what we do with the recreation brochure and may have to go all digital.

Councilperson Sharpe reported Farmers Museum meeting has been scheduled and they are looking for volunteers.

Supervisor Hayles reported notification from Town Engineer MRB Group that the USDA has asked for additional information and have recommended funding for the water project on LaDue, Swamp, West Sweden Road. This is not a guarantee of funding, but the application is moving forward.

Supervisor Hayles attended the Supervisors' meeting. Discussion regarding water districts and consequences of not maintaining 100% valuation. Mrs. Hayles attended the warming center ribbon cutting event at the Brockport Baptist Church. The NYS SUNY Chancellor was at SUNY Brockport sharing information with college personnel and local officials. Mrs. Hayles shared the important economic impact the college has here and how vital the college is to our community.
